NEW Dress Code for the Clubhouse and the Golf Course

Please note this policy has been revised for the 2023 season

It is expected that Members, their children and guests will be in Country Club appropriate attire at all times while on Club premises. **This DOES NOT include blue denim of any type (no blue denim jackets), tank tops, cargo shorts or pants, "short shorts", leggings, athletic attire (other than golf) or bare feet.** White denim is permitted. Appropriate attire includes properly fitted clothing that is not ripped, torn, faded, revealing, cut-off or frayed. All tops must be tucked into pants or skirts, except for tops designed to be worn over the skirt or pants.

Men's shirts must have sleeves and a collar. This includes children thirteen years and older. It is expected that gentlemen will wear hats with the bill facing forward when on the golf course and remove them in the Clubhouse.

The same dress code applies to the entire Clubhouse including all dining areas and locker rooms. Gentlemen are encouraged, but not required, to wear jackets in the Bay Room on Easter Sunday, Mother's Day and Thanksgiving.

Shoes: Shoes are required in all areas of the Clubhouse. On the golf course and the practice areas, only soft soled or soft spike golf shoes are permitted.

Please note: The General Manager and the Golf Professional are responsible for enforcing this dress code. Clubhouse and golf course privileges will not be granted to Members and guests who violate these rules. The dress code applies to children as well.

GREENS DEPARTMENT

Welcome back to Eastward Ho!. Over the past few months our team has been hard at work improving all facets of the golf course. We began our Mainline Irrigation Project on January 2nd and our Golf Course Improvement Project on holes 3 and 11 on February 5th. Both projects are on time and on budget as planned.

Golf Course Improvement and Enhancement

Our team and Kyle Franz & Co. have been hard at work and have several exciting improvements to holes 3 and 11.

Bunker Improvements: The current bunker sand and surrounding grasses were removed. The bunkers were then reshaped to improve playability and aesthetics. Playability is improved by widening the play areas and encouraging balls to end up there. Safety is improved at the left fairway bunker on the 3rd hole as you can now see more fairway and green through the bunker, meaning more visibility toward the group in front of you. After reshaping, Eastward Ho!'s grass is laid back onto the surrounds of the bunker and new, firmer sand is added. This sand is a bit brighter and will be up for thorough evaluation throughout the 2024 season.

New Tee Construction: The new mid-tee on hole 3 is complete and provides greater variety and enjoyment. The same applies to the new back tees on 3 and 11, although they may not be 100% complete at the time of this article publication.

New Native Sandy Areas (NSAs): Hole 3 has new NSAs left of the landing area. These areas are mostly sand and are defined with a grass edge at the fairway and the left edge of the Native grass. There are clumps of individual grass plants that peek up through the sand and help to hold some of the subtle rolls within the NSA. Drainage is accounted for and much of the heavier topsoil and clay was removed in the area left of the fairway. These soils are the reason that this area of the course always had such "healthy" Native grasses. The removed topsoil remains on site and will be utilized

New HDPE Mainline Irrigation

Beginning January 2nd, we have installed **three miles** of mainline HDPE pipe for our new irrigation system. The entire back nine, driving range, and holes 1, 9, and 2 have been completely installed. This process includes removing sod, excavating the trench, installing the new mainline, fusing of all valves that attach to the mainline (fairway laterals, tee/green shutoffs, drains, and air reliefs), backfilling the trench, and replacing the sod that was removed. Our efforts, along with the dedication and hard work of our excellent contractor Winterberry Irrigation, have allowed this process to run smooth and efficient. With reasonable weather, we do expect to complete the mainline installation on the front nine early this spring. The progress made this winter is a great foundation to start from when construction begins October 1st, setting us up to handle and conquer any bad weather that could potentially delay our work and projects.

during the course improvement project. Left of the approach area we have a NSA that contains a new cart area system to get you to the 3rd green and 4th teeing area. This cart area will be contained within the NSA to provide a more natural appearance. The area is a mixture of sand, clumps of individual grasses, and grass. Historic subtle mounds have been added left of the approach providing interest and further "hiding" the cart area. There are new NSAs to the right of the fairway as well. These are more cavitated than left of the fairway to help hold balls on the right edge of our property. These areas also contain clumps of individual grasses and much shallower depths of sand as compared to bunkers.

New chipping and putting area left of the 3rd green: This area had the sod removed and is reshaped to improve playability. This will now be mowed at fairway height, like many of our other green surrounds, providing many incredible shot options if you find yourself left of the green. We created this area with history in mind. This allowed for two subtle bumps at the left edge of the collar area. These historic bumps give support to shots coming into the green and provide for additional hole locations front left above the newly reshaped left greenside bunker. You may decide to play further down the right side of the fairway to attack this expanded area of the green.

Hole 11 was just getting started when this article was written so we will leave that description of work for a later time.
